- 1. Approval of the municipal charter by Vihiga County Assembly is a major achievement that took place in the 1st quarter of the year.
- Identification of board members, vetting and eventually appointment was a key
 milestone. This was followed by unveiling of the municipal board members in a lively
 swearing in ceremony held at the County headquarters and attended by the top leadership
 of the County.

3. Formation of County Project Coordination Team (CPCT) as well as the appointment of an acting municipal manager was also an achievement in the second quarter of the financial year.

CHALLENGES AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- a) Preparation of bill of quantities was a challenge as there were very few personnel with expertise and the one available were also very busy meaning it took much longer time to get bill of quantities. In some cases we had to get assistance from other counties that were implementing similar works.
- b) County website was down for about a week meaning interested people could not access the information required. The advertisement period was extended for a week to compensate for the period the net was down.
- c) Electronic procurement has several challenges because its new and there are very few officers in the County who fully understand it's working. We were constantly consulting national treasury to assist contractors who had challenges of uploading their application on the ifmis system. Getting ifmis number for respective projects was not an easy task as some times the system would be down and this was causing some delay. Officers working in the procurement office were trained on e-procurement. There is need for refresher courses and training on e-procurement and ifmis.
- d) Late disbursement of funds UDG and UIG.
