## Vihiga County Finance Bill THE VIHIGA COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2024 ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

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#### THE VIHIGA COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2024

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Vihiga to provide for the imposition or variation of various fees, charges, licenses, rents and rates for services and for connected purposes

**ENACTED** by the County Assembly of Vihiga, as follows—

#### PART I—PRELIMINARY

#### Short title and commencement

1. This Act, may be cited as the Vihiga County Finance Act, 2024 and shall come in to operation on the fourteenth day following publication in the *Kenya Gazette*.

#### **Interpretation**

No.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

"advertisement" means any notice or representation employed wholly or partly for the purpose of drawing the attention of the public to or promoting any product or service;

"authorized channel" means the manner in which a person may effect payment to the County Government, including but not limited to a person designated by the county executive committee member pursuant to Section 157 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 to collect or receive revenue or any other mode of payment as may be prescribed from time to time;

"business" means—

- (a) trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (b) any other activity in the nature of trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (c) any activity carried out by a person continuously or regularly, whether or not for gain or profit and which involves, in part or in whole, the supply of goods or services for consideration;

"cess" means a levy charged on tradable agricultural and natural resources within the county;

"county" means Vihiga County;

"County Government" means the County Government of Vihiga; "County Public Officer" means a county public officer within themeaning of Section 2 of the County Governments Act, 2012;

"County Receiver of Revenue" has the same meaning assigned to the word "receiver of revenue" in paragraph (b) of Section 157 of the Public Finance Management Act;

"County Revenue Collector" has the same meaning assigned to the word "collector of revenue" in paragraph (b) of Section 2 of the Public Finance Management Act means the County Public Officer appointed pursuant to Section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012;

"Executive Committee Member" means the County Executive Committee Member for the time being responsible for matters relating to finance in the County;

"hearse" means a vehicle tailor made for transporting/conveying a deceased person;

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"Municipality" means the geographical area defined by the Vihiga Municipality gazette notice number 2545 of 31st January 2024

"person" means a natural or juristic person;

"Zone A" means the area comprising of the faraway areas previously under the defunct Vihiga County Council;

"Zone B" means the area comprising of the fair/prime areas previously under the defunct Vihiga County Council;

"Zone C" means the area comprising of the faraway areas previouslyunder the defunct Luanda Urban Council and Vihiga Municipality;

"Zone D" means the area comprising of the fair/prime location areas previously under the defunct Luanda Municipal Council and Vihiga Municipality.

#### PART II— FEES AND TAXES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE

#### **General Fees and Charges**

- **3.** (1) A person who wishes to carry out the activities specified in the Second Column of the First Schedule shall pay the respective fees specified in the Fifth Column of the same Schedule.
- (2) A person who wishes to engage in any of the activities specified in Part IV of the First Schedule shall first apply for a permit from the County Government in the prescribed form and on payment of the prescribed fees before commencing the activity.
- (3) Subsection (2) of this section shall not apply to persons applying for renewal of single business permit.
- (4) A person who wishes to carry out activities specified in the First Schedule shall pay to the County Government the respective fees prescribed in the Vihiga Trade Licensing Act, 2017 as amended.
- (5) The County Executive Member shall, by notice in writing through the established channel of communication in operation in the county, prescribe the fees payable for single business permit.
- (6) Every distributor wishing to operate in the county shall first apply to the County Government in the prescribed form for a distributor permit on payment of the prescribed fees before commencement of operation.
- (7) There shall be paid, together with the prescribed fees, a cumulative monthly penalty of three percent for every late payment for single business permit.
- (8) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

#### **Parking Fees and Penalties**

- **4.** (1) A person who uses County parking shall pay the fee specified in the Second Schedule.
- (2) A person who fails to pay parking fee resulting in impounding of a vehicle or service upon him or her of summons requiring court attendance shall, in order to recover the impounded vehicle or withdraw the summons, pay the penalties prescribed in the Second Schedule.

#### **Solid Waste and Environmental Management**

5. A person who wishes to receive or carry out the services specified in the

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Second Column of the Third Schedule at the unit measure specified in the Third Column of the same Schedule shall pay the fee specified in the Fourth Column of that Schedule.

## **Lands and Physical Planning Fees**

- **6.** (1) A person who wishes to construct a building or structure on any land in the county shall apply for a construction permit to the County Department responsible for Physical Planning on payment of the fees prescribed in the Fourth Schedule accompanied by an approved plan for the building or structure.
- (2) A person who commences construction of a building or structure without the appropriate approved plan commits an offence and shall be liable in addition to the punishment prescribed in this Act, to pay the penalties specified in the Fourth Schedule.

#### **Rental payments**

- 7. (1) A person occupying a plot, stall or a building leased or rented out by the County Government shall pay rent, at the rate specified in the last column of the relevant Part of the Fourth Schedule.
  - (2) The rent referred to under in sub-section (1) shall be due and payable by—
  - (a) in the case of a plot, on the 1st day of January in each year; and
  - (b) in the case of a house or a stall, on the 10th day of each subsequent month.
- (3) A person who defaults to pay the rent prescribed under this section shall be issued with a three months notice and be liable to eviction from the premises without other notice on the expiry of the sixth month.
- (4) A penalty of three percent per month shall be charged on the outstanding rent on a plot that remains unpaid after the 31st day of March of the relevant year.
- (5) The County may repossess the plot referred to under in subsection if the person fails to pay rent for more than six months.
- (6) Any rent arrears accrued under this section may be recovered through civil proceedings in a court of law.

#### **Hire of Machinery**

- **8.** (1) A person who wishes to use a county machine shall first apply for a permit to the relevant department of the County Government in the prescribed form on payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (2) of this section.
- (2) No permit shall be granted for hire of county machine for a period of less than four hours and every charge for use of county machine under this section shall be on four-hour basis
- (3) any person who violates subsection (2) of this section commits an offence and if a public officer, shall be liable to disciplinary proceedings

#### **Infrastructure and Maintenance Fee**

- **9.** (1) A person who operates a quarry or transports quarry products, red soil, or manure from or through the County shall upon application in the prescribed form, pay a fee prescribed in the Second Schedule-
- (2) A person transporting agricultural products from or through the County shall upon an application in the prescribed form be charged the fee prescribed in the First Schedule.
- (3) a person who violates any provision of this section commits an offence.

### Fees for use of County Stadia, Grounds or Halls

- 10. (1) A person who wishes to use the county stadia, grounds hall or other facility shall apply in the prescribed form for a permit from the relevant department of the County Government on payment of the fee prescribed in the Sixth Schedule.
- (2) A person who uses or permits the use of County Stadia, Ground, Hall or other facility in contravention of the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in this Act.

#### **Food and Drugs Permit and Health Services**

- 11. (1) A person who wishes to sell any product, operate a business or receive any service related to or connected with food, drugs or health services shall first apply for a permit from the relevant department of the County Government in the prescribed form on payment of the fee prescribed in the Seventh Schedule.
- (2) Where the relevant Department of the County government is to provide the services specified in the Seventh Schedule, the fee specified in that Schedule shall apply.

#### **Livestock and Veterinary Services Fees**

12. A person who wishes to sell the products, operate the business or receive the services specified in Part I of the Eighth Schedule including sale of food and drugs or receipt of county services related to or connected with livestock or veterinary services shall first apply for a permit from the relevant department of the County Government in the prescribed form on payment of the fee prescribed in that Schedule.

#### **Public Medical Health Services**

13. A person who receives medical or health services from the health facilities of the County Government specified in the Seventh Schedule shall pay the charges specified in that Schedule or in other county legislation whichever is applicable

#### Advertisement

**14.** A person who wishes to display advertisements and signages specified in the Ninth Schedule shall apply for a permit to the County Department responsible for Revenue administration in the prescribed form on payment of the fee prescribed in that Schedule.

#### **Tax Waivers Variations**

- (1) The Executive Committee Member for Finance may in writing, exempt, waive or vary fees or charges payable under this Act in accordance to the criteria prescribed in the Act. In a notice published in the Gazette.
- (2) An application for a tax exemption, waiver or variation shall be inwriting and shall be submitted to the Executive Committee member.
- (3) Despite any provision of this section, Persons Living with Disabilities in possession of a valid certificate of disability shall be entitled to a waiver of forty percent of the respective taxes, fees and charges as provided in this Act.

#### **Impoundment Yards**

15. The areas and offices within the designaated Sub-County revenue offices in every Sub-County, and the Vihiga Municipal Grounds and the County Government headquarters in Mbale Town shall serve as yards for storage of impounded goods.

#### **Amendments of the Schedules**

- **16.** (1) The Executive Committee Member may with the approval of the County Executive Committee and by an order published in the *Gazette* amend any of the Schedules.
- (2) Any order under sub-section (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly for approval without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within the next twenty-one days on which it next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse, but without prejudice to anything previously done under the order.

#### PART III—PAYMENT

#### **Payments to the County**

- 17. (1) All payments due to the County shall be paid through authorized channels notified by the revenue collector or enforcement officer.
- (2) A County Revenue Collector or Enforcement Officer enforcing this Act shall have an Identification Card issued by the County.
- (3) The identification card issued under sub-section (2) shall be worn visibly by the officer when carrying out any of the functions under this Act.
- (4) An official receipt shall be issued for every payments made to the County.
- (5) Any payment made to the County shall be evidenced by an official receipt.
- (6) A person shall not receive or collect any money due to or on behalf of the County Government as revenue unless he has been authorized to do so under this Act.
- (7) Any revenue collector or enforcement officer who violates any provision of this section shall be guilty of misconduct and liable to disciplinary proceedings prescribed in the human resource management policies governing county public service.

#### **Appointment and duties of an Agent**

**18.** Appointment and duties of an agent shall be in accordance with the legislation governing revenue administration in the County

### **Seizure (impounding) of Goods**

- **19.** (1) An Authorized Revenue Collector may seize or impound goods if he has reasonable grounds to believe that revenue in respect of the goods has not been paid.
- (2) Goods seized or impounded under sub-section (1) shall be recorded in a register maintained for the purpose and stored in a place approved by the County Receiver of Revenue in a manner to ensure the safety and security of the goods.
- (3) When the goods referred to in sub-section (1), have been seized or impounded, the Authorized Revenue Collector shall, having regard to

the conditions of the goods, serve the owner of the goods or the person who had the custody or control of the goods, a notice in writing—

- (a) identifying the goods;
- (b) stating that the goods have been seized under this section and the reasons for seizure;
- (c) setting out the terms for the release or disposal of the goods; and
- (d) stating that the goods shall be forfeited to the County, if not claimed in accordance with subsection (4).
- (4) The County Receiver of Revenue or Authorized Revenue Collector shall authorize the goods to be released, to whom the notice was served under subsection (3), upon payment of revenue due and payable together with any penalties and cost that may have accrued from the seizure or impoundment of the goods.
- (5) If subsection (4) does not apply, the Authorized Revenue Collector in consultation with the County Receiver of Revenue or the authorized revenue collector shall detain the goods seized or impounded under sub-section (1) —
- (a) in case of perishable goods, for a period that is reasonable but not exceeding forty eight hours, having regards to the conditions of the goods; or
  - (b) in any other case, for thirty days after the seizure.
- (6) When the retention period under sub-section (5) has expired, the goods shall be treated as having been forfeited to the County Receiver of Revenue and shall be disposed of by public auction or private treaty in accordance with the provisions of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015 or county policy on disposal of assets and the proceeds paid into the County Revenue Account.
- (7) The county government shall not bear any cost, loss, loss of user or damage to the impounded items, goods or any other property unless caused by willful or negligent act or omission of its officer or officers the burden of proof whereof shall lie on the claimant

## PART IV—OFFENCES AND PENALTIES UNDER THE ACT

#### **General offences and penalties**

**20.** Subject to section 22 Any person who violates any provision of this Act, commits an offence, and shall be liable on conviction, where no other penalty is provided, to a fine not exceeding twenty thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or both.

## Offences by Staff of the County

- **21.** (1) A member of staff of the County, agent or any other person having a duty to perform under this Act who—
  - (a) makes, in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry
  - (b) which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false:
  - (c) willfully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to know is required to be done;
  - (d) interferes with any other person or process under this Act, so as to defeat the provisions, requirements or purposes of this Act;
  - (e) where required under this Act to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Act, fails to do such thing;
  - (f) without reasonable cause avoids to do something in breach of his or her duty under this Act;
  - (g) willfully contravenes the provisions of this Act to give undue advantage or favor to another person; or
  - (h) fails to prevent or report to the County Government or any other relevant authority, an offence committed under this Act, Commits an offence.
- (2) A person who is found guilty of an offence under sub-section (1) of this section shall be liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or both.

#### PART V— MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

#### **Savings**

- **22.** (1) (a) Any charges, permit fees, licenses fees, rent, infrastructure maintenance fee and such other fees payable to the County at the commencement of this Act but which are not included in any of the Schedules to this Act, shall continue to apply as though the same were provided in this Act.
- (2) All orders, directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on, or relating to financial management, including the collection and administration of fees and charges given or issued by the previous county councils, municipal councils, town councils or urban councils, before the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made by or under this Act, until the revocation, expiry or repeal of those

notices directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations, and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, to apply, be paid and administered under this Act:

Provided that this sub-section shall also apply to such fees and charges levied by various ministries and departments of the National Government in respect of functions devolved to the County under Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution which fees and charges shall be levied by the County on performance of the devolved functions.

(2) All references to Councils shall include all Local Authorities as were defined under the now repealed Local Government Act, Cap. 265 of the Laws of Kenya.

#### Cessation

23. Unless otherwise provided in this Act, the rates for fees, charges, licenses, cess or rent applicable to the goods, services or Activities listed in the Schedules which applied before the commencement on this Act shall cease to apply on commencement of this Act but without prejudice to the right of the County Government to recover any unpaid or outstanding arrears owe by a person on the date of commencement

### Regulations

**24.** The Executive Committee Member may make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Act.

#### **Advance Payments**

- **25.** (1) Notwithstanding the units of measure of time provided in the Schedules to this Act the Executive Committee Member may issue guidelines for receipt of advance payments for a period of Three (3), Six (6) and Twelve (12) months.
- (2) Where a person elects to pay in advance as in sub-section (a), the County shall issue a special card showing the details of the payment and expiry of the same.
- (3) The Executive Committee Member may with approval of the County Executive Committee provide for discounts under this section to encourage advance and timely payments.
- (4) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.
